Keynote Speaker:  
Dr. Becky Wai-Ling Packard



Dr. Becky Wai-Ling Packard is an Associate Professor of Psychology and Education at Mount Holyoke College. Her research focuses on the mentoring of women pursuing science and

technology careers; the aspirations and mentoring of urban ethnic minority low-income adolescents, especially in science and technology; and understanding the complex pathways toward higher education. Her numerous scholarly articles have been published in such journals as *Career Development Quarterly*, *Mentoring and Tutoring*, *Journal of Career Development*, *Journal of College Science Teaching*, *Advancing Women in Leadership*, and *Journal of Adolescent and Adult Literacy*. In 2005, Professor Packard traveled to the White House to receive the Presidential Early Career Award for Scientists and Engineers, the highest honor bestowed by the U.S. government upon early career scientists.

We are honored to have Dr. Packard as our keynote speaker for this conference, and know you will be inspired by her presentation.
